The following items were discussed:

Downtown Event Parking Recommendation

Upon recommendation by Police Chief Michael Moore, Council Members requested City Staff, in coordination with the City Attorney, to draft a proposed ordinance establishing temporary no parking zones downtown during city events. Further discussion will be held following Council review and feedback.

M4 Agreement/IT Services

Jeremy Nagy discussed the renewal of a four-year agreement with M4 Technology Corp. to provide technical support, design, installation, and maintenance for existing city information technology operations, software assistance, troubleshooting, and maintenance of existing information technology infrastructure at a cost of \$8,500 per month. Following a brief discussion, a recommendation was made to renew the agreement for a five-year period to coincide with the current administrative term.

Council Members conducted a review of the June 1, 2021 Council Meeting agenda. Following review, no changes were requested by the Council.

Bonds/Projects Update


City Administrator Jonathan Tullos provided an update on the Series 2021 General Obligation Warrants and related capital improvement projects.

Street Resurfacing Project/Phase II


Consulting Engineer Glenn Morgan discussed the current status of the city's street resurfacing project.
