

2021 Adventure Summer Camp FAQs

1. When will registration open?
 - a. Adventure Summer Camp registration will begin Monday, May 3rd at 8 AM at the Recreation Center and end once spots are filled. **SPOTS ARE LIMITED!**
2. Can I register online?
 - a. No. 2021 Registration will only be offered in-person only at the Jug Brown Recreation Center. Payment and paperwork are due at the time of registration.
3. What's required at the time of registration?
 - a. Copy of valid birth certificate. Make sure you already have a birth certificate on file with us to make registration faster! Call us at 334-348-2684 to confirm.
 - b. Full payment for the first camp session.
 - c. Completed required forms (may be downloaded online, picked up at the Rec Center, or filled out in-person during registration).
4. What ages will 2021 Adventure Summer Camp accept?
 - a. We are accepting campers ages 6-11 as of September 1, 2021. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
5. How do I learn more about Adventure Summer Camp?
 - a. Our Adventure Camp documents (Policies & Procedures handbook, monthly calendars, etc.) are available online at <https://www.enterpriseal.gov/281/Adventure-Summer-Camp>
 - b. Following registration, parents/guardians will be required to attend one (of two) Parent/Guardian Orientation meetings that will offer further information.
6. Which COVID-19 Precautions will be in place?
 - a. We will follow all mandates provided by the state of Alabama and the CDC.
7. What are the dates for the camp season?
 - a. Camp will begin Monday, June 7th and end Friday, July 30th. **There will be no camp on Monday, July 5th.**
 - b. Camp will be 4 sessions. Each session consists of 2 weeks.
8. How many sessions are available at the time of registration?
 - a. Registration will only take place for Session 1 and during registration you can select which sessions you intend to attend. Once spots are filled, a waitlist will begin. We will use the waitlist to fill any empty slots in future sessions.
9. What is the registration fee per session?
 - a. Adventure Camp will operate on a bi-weekly payment schedule.
 - b. Registration does not guarantee a spot holder for your child, **you must make a payment to hold your child's spot for future sessions by the stated due date.**

**Each session will consist of at least one guest speaker, one field trip, 4 art & crafts, and 2 sports demos.*

10. Will meals be provided?
 - a. Campers will be provided breakfast and lunch during the day by way of the city's Summer Feeding Program during weeks 2-7.
 - b. During weeks 1 and 8, campers will be required to bring their own meals.
 - c. Snack is not guaranteed and will be provided as available; however, we encourage parents to pack their children a snack or make use of our vending machines.
11. What are some necessities my child should bring with him/her to camp?
 - a. Comfortable clothes
 - b. Water bottle
 - c. Sunscreen
12. When will I need to drop off and pick up my child?
 - a. Campers may be dropped off as early as 7:30AM. Breakfast will end at 9AM and camp activities will begin. Campers may be picked up beginning at 5PM. All campers must be picked up by 5:30PM or late fees will be charged.
13. Will an ID be required to pick up my child?
 - a. Parents/guardians will receive drop-off/pick-up signs for camp staff to view to verify identification at pick-up time. If a drop-off/pick-up card is not presented, an ID will be required.
14. What will my child experience week-to-week at camp?
 - a. Every week of camp will have a different theme. We encourage our campers and staff to have fun with these themes and feel free to wear clothes/accessories that correlate. The campers will have themed activities and crafts every week. The themes are below:

Week 1: Color Explosion Week

Week 2: Lights, Camera, Adventure Week

Week 3: Kingdom: Animalia Week

Week 4: Party in the USA Week

Week 5: STEM Week

Week 6: Showcase Week

Week 7: Tropical Week
